Information we collect from you

We will collect and process the following data:

Personal information you give us

How do we use your personal information?

We process your information for purposes based on legitimate business interests, compliance with our legal obligations, and/or your consent.

Information you give to us.

We will use this information:

If we are under a duty to disclose or share your personal data to comply with any legal obligation, or to enforce or apply our terms of use and other agreements; or to protect the rights, property, or safety of Viridian Consulting Engineers Limited, our customers, or others. This includes exchanging information with other companies and organisations for the purposes of fraud protection.

Where we store your personal data
